Eastern Washington Democrat Raises Over \$100,000 for State Senate Campaign

Walla Walla, WA - Danielle Garbe Reser, the Democratic candidate for State Senate in Washington's 16th Legislative District, has now raised over \$100,000 for her campaign.

"I am extremely grateful for the investment that so many individuals have made in this race and for their shared commitment to building a bright future for everyone in our region," said Garbe Reser. "I am running to bring Eastern Washington values to Olympia, bridging our rural and urban communities and listening to all political perspectives. Given the new challenges confronting our state, it is even more critical for Eastern Washington's rural communities to have a voice in the room where decisions will be made about our state's economic recovery -- the Democratic caucus room."

In just 86 days of fundraising between January 21 and April 15, Danielle raised \$100,086 from 612 individuals and two political action committees, Win With Women and Teamsters Local 839. As of March 31, 2020, Danielle had raised more than double both of her Republican opponents' combined fundraising totals.

Danielle is a proud American, community builder, and farmer's wife in Walla Walla who has dedicated her life to serving our country and our communities. During her nearly 14 years of serving our country as a diplomat, she worked for both Republican and Democratic administrations, including as a staff member to then-Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice and two tours at the National Security Council during the Obama Administration. From 2015 until early 2020, she was the CEO of Sherwood Trust, a private foundation that invests in community and economic development in Walla Walla and Columbia Counties.

The 16th Legislative District includes all of Walla Walla and Columbia Counties and parts of Franklin and Benton Counties, including the cities of Pasco and Prosser. The 16th Legislative District Senate Seat is open as the current incumbent, Maureen Walsh, has announced her retirement. The last Democrat to hold the seat was Valoria Loveland from 1993-2001.
